This week is Lutheran Schools Week. We will be participating in fun games and dress down days. We will be working around a different schedule this week due to the fun we will be having. Also, in February, the students will have their third grade spotlight weekend at church (11th and 12th) and will be leading Chapel one Wednesday (15th) at 2:25 pm. I will send more information out as the time draws nearer.

What we are learning-

Religion- This week we will be learning about what the church year is and why God's word is at the heart of worship.
