SUNDAY SCHOOL

Sunday School for potty-trained children, ages 3 – 5th grade, meets at 9:20 a.m. on Sunday mornings in the Music Room at school for a short opening and then breaks into groups for the Bible story, a craft, snack or lesson extension. We are learning how JESUS shows us He is TRUE GOD.

THIS Sunday, January 29th – "Jesus and the Samaritan Woman at the Well" We learn that Jesus gives the Spirit, who cleanses us from sin and unrighteousness in the living water of Holy Baptism. Parents, talk with your children about how sin causes us to have guilt and shame before God. Emphasize that through the water and the Word of Holy Baptism all guilt and shame are removed. Discuss that "Jesus comes for all people no matter what race or color they are. Ordinary water leaves us thirsting for more, but the living water of Jesus, which flows from His Word and the baptismal font, quenches our spiritual thirst forever."

Second Article of the Apostles Creed Explanation
